Recognition:

SVM Public School is an English Medium co-educational school which strives to meet the challenging need of providing comprehensive quality education to develop the various facets of a child's personality.

This school is managed by the registered body of Saraswati Vidya Mandir which has been in existence since 1964.

This branch of SVM Public School at Maniram was laid in the session 2015-16, with the concept of providing education from Nursery to senior secondary classes. Now, we are a CBSE affiliated Senior Secondary institution with class Nur-XII having affiliation No. 2132772

Location:

The school is located on Gorakhpur Sonauli Road at Chiutaha, Maniram, Gorakhpur.

Curriculum:

The course of study followed in school is in accordance with the syllabus prescribed by the CBSE, New Delhi.

The Curriculum includes the following subject:

(a) Pre-Primary section (Nur., LKG, UKG)

English, Hindi, Math, G.K., Conversation, Drawing.

(b) Primary Section (I - V)


English, Hindi, Maths, Science, S. St., G.K., Conversation, Computer, Art / Craft, Sanskrit.

(c) Middle Section (VI - VIII)

English, Hindi, Maths, Science, S.St. G.K., Computer, Sanskrit, Art / Craft

(d) Secondary Section (IX - X)

English, Hindi, Maths, Science, Social-Studies, Computer, Workexperience, Physical and Health Education, Art Education.





Registration/Admission:

Admission are granted to all boys and girls irrespective of caste, creed or social status.

Admission is possible if there is a vacancy in a particular class. Registration does not, in any way, guarantee admission.

Registration/Admission:-

a. Primary (I to Vth):

The minimum age limit for class-I (The first stage of primary) is 7+. It goes on in the same way for other classes. There will be admission test and interview for the students seeking admission in primary classes. The subjects of admission test will be English, Hindi and Mathematics.

A child who qualifies the written test and an interview but fails to fulfil the required age limit will not be given admission to the class which he/she desires.

b. Junior (VI-VIII) :

Admission to Junior classes will be permitted only after qualifying a written test and an interview. Written test will be taken in curriculum subjects like English, Hindi, Mathematics.

Candidates taking admission in primary shall be valid upto class-v. for promotion to class VI, either
the students shall have to secure 60% marks in all subjects in class-v annual examination or have to
sit in the entrance test meant for outside students for admission in class-VI.



- Students studying in class-VI or taken admission in class VI after qualifying in the entrance test shall be valid upto class-VIII.
 - The list of the successful candidates shall be pasted on the school Notice Board on the date given.
 - 4. Date and time for the written test and interview will be assigned at the time of registration.
 - 5. The original Report Card (Mark Sheet) of the qualifying examination is required at the time of interview.
 Parents of successful candidates in the Entrance Test shall report to the office with the following documents and must meet the Principal together with their wards at the time of admission (within the dates as notified for the purpose):-
 - a. Photo copy of the Birth certificate from a competent authority along with original copy.
 - b. Transfer Certificate from the school last attended and a copy of the report card along with the original.
 - Two recent Passport size photographs of the students.
 - Admission fee once paid is not refundable in the event of withdrawal of the candidate for whatever reason it may be.
 - e. Dates for distribution of registration form, entrance test, declaration of result, admission etc. will be displayed on the Notice Board. No application for any change of date for admission will be entertained.
- C. Admission to secondary classes and senior secondary classes Admission to these Classes will be permitted only after qualifying written test and an Interview, Written test will be taken in English, Hindi, Maths, Science for secondary classes and in English, Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Bio, Commerce for senior secondary classes, as per the demand of stream.

Note:

- At the time of admission, every student must produce a Transfer Certificate from the school last attended and a copy of Aadhar. Unless the T.C. is produced, admission granted will be treated as provisional.
- Admission of a student is renewed every year depending upon his/her over all performance, work and behavior. If a student is not considered to have fared well or earns adverse reports, about his/ her work or behavior from the teachers, his/her name may be removed from, the scholar's register without any notice.

Evaluation and Promotion:

Through out the academic year, besides the terminal exam, class tests and internal assessment are taken and they are of paramount importance for students as regards promotion to the next class.

SCHOOL EXAMINATION & PROGRESS REPORT:

Pre-Primary (Nur., L.K.G. & U.K.G.) - 2 Term End Assessment.

Class: (I-XII) - As per CBSE Norms. Result: Between 25th to 30th March

Note: These Dates may stagger depending upon weather/circumstances.

- 1- Progress of the student is assessed on the basis of half yearly and annual examinations.
- 2- Promotion is granted on the basis of the entire year's work.
 The annual examination is meant to confirm the result of the year's work. The decision of the school authorities regarding promotion is final.
- 3- The portion for examination will be given one month before.
- 4- There will be no examination or re-examination out of schedule.
- 5- It is compulsory to obtain min. 40% marks in written papers of each subject besides pass marks in total.

School Timings:

Summers : 7:55 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. (April to October)
Winters : 8:55 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. (November to March)

Note: Students will not be allowed to enter the school campus after the scheduled time.

If parents require to discuss their ward's problem, they are kindly requested to come and meet the
class teacher at the time of school dispersal on any working day.

School Conveyance.

The school has got its own fleet of buses for providing transport facility to the students. Those who want to avail this facility are required to fill up the necessary form.











Educational Enrichment

Library: The school is running a good library with books on various subjects to meet both curricular and co-curricular requirements of teachers and students.





Science Labs: The school is having spacious and well equipped science Lab for middle classes and Physics, Chemistry and Biology Labs separately for secondary and senior secondary classes.

Computer labs: Looking to the latest requirements to meet the challenges and changes the school is having computer labs updated with multimedia and internet concept.





Teaching Through smart Class: To endure clarity of concept and to make the subject interesting, purposeful and throughout provoking the school has equipped class room with multimedia system for computer aided teaching.

Sports and Games: The school lays great emphasis on sports and games believing firmly that through this medium a child can imbibe the basic human qualities of fair play, sportsmanship, a spirit of competition and qualities of leadership. The school has large playground and provides all facilities for sports and games such as Cricket, Volleyball, Basketball, Badminton etc.











Evaluation of Academic Works:

The promotion to the next class is based on cumulative assessment for the year, taking into account all the boosters and terminal examinations, oral tests, project, class-work, home-work and extra-curricular activities. The passing marks is 33%.

MORNING ASSEMBLY:

Morning assembly is held every day followed by "Thought for the Day" and "News" read by students and moral teaching by teachers. Regular P.T. is held after that. A brief time is also allotted to increase the general knowledge of our students.

Attendance

- Students must be punctual and regular in attendance. Leave application must be submitted to the Principal's office. In case of illness and other unforeseen circumstances, the guardian should inform the Principal in written form within two days. A minimum attendance of 90% of the total working days is required during the academic year. A student returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, should produce a doctor's certificate, permitting him/her to attend the school.
- Every student must be present on the re-opening day after each vacation.
- No leave other than Medical leave will be sanctioned during the examination.
- Attendance is compulsory, on National Festivals such as the "Independence Day", "Republic Day" etc. Absence on these days will be punishable.

Discipline

Students are expected to maintain a high standard of good manners, behaviour and etiquette. If a child is found involved in any undesired activity or exhibiting an offensive attitude, she/he will be expelled from the school on charges of indiscipline.

English Speaking is must, Students not adhering to this will be fined. Students can be expelled from the school any time if they fail to follow school rules.



Co-curricular Activities & S.u.p.w. -

The school offers a variety of hobbies and activities. Every student is supposed to take part and co-operate in the various school activities such as debating, delivering speech, essay writing, quiz etc. Additional arrangements for Music, Art, Dance, Model making, Clay work, Pottery, Gardening, Stitching and Embroidery etc. have been made for the students. These activities help in carrying out a balanced personality in an individual which help to tide over adolescence safely into adulthood.

Our English and Hindi Literary Societies organise Debate, Declamation test, Quiz competition, Essay writing and Hand writing competition.

The Cultural Society organises competitions in Dramatics, Painting & Music.

RECOMMENDATION TO THE PARENTS:

- Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities by ensuring that the children observe punctuality and discipline, neat & clean school uniform, prepare their lessons and take active part in the activities of the school.
- 2. Parents should check the School Diary and sign the report recorded by the teachers and home-work given.
- Parents/guardians are requested to keep themselves in touch with the school to have a clear knowledge of their ward's progress in studies.
- Parents are not allowed to meet the teachers in the classroom or in the staff-room. Those who wish to seek
 information, suggestion or make complaint about their children's education or other matters may meet the
 Principal between 9:30 to 10:30 a.m. (only on Tue., Wed., Thu. & Sat.)
- School authorities will be responsible for the students only during school hours and inside school campus.
- Parents must submit three passport size photographs of the person to whom the ward is to be handed over duly attested by the parents as, the child will not be send along with any person other than whose name and attested photo is recorded in school.
- If parents require to discuss their ward's problem, they are kindly requested to come and meet the class teacher at the time of school dispersal.
- Parents must not give cash amount for fee deposition, it can be in the form of cheque for which sufficient balance in account must be maintained.

Relation Between Parents And Children:

- Harsh and coercive means of punishment should not be used in disciplining the children. They are to be trained through love and affection.
- Help your children to set their own individual goals in life and then assist them to attain excellence in all the undertakings.
- Do not allow your children to play out on the street with other kids and be very careful about the company they keep.

Visiting Hours

Parents can meet the Principal between 09:30 to 11:30 a.m. on Tue., Wed., Thur. & Sat. To see the Principal the guardians may use the visiting book kept at the counter.

Fee

- 1. Fee can be paid for the entire session together with the first installment.
- All dues and arrears should be clear before examinations.
- 3. Kindly get the receipt and keep it carefully.

The Days for the payment of fee

** If any holiday falls during the fee dates, the fee date will be extended beyond the specified dates by the number of holiday/holidays for acceptance of fee.

Late Payment: Last date of payment of fees will be 15" of every month, failing which Rs 50/- per month as late fee would be charged. If the defaulter is unable to clear his/her dues within 30 days, his/her name will be struck off the rolls and re-admission would be allowed only if all dues are cleared along with Rs. 300/- as re-admission charges, that too after completing the admission formalities as fresh.



Withdrawl Procedure:

- ÿ If any parents want to take T.C. after completion of session they have to submit application before 31st March otherwise they have to pay one month fees for the next class.
- Y If the child is withdrawn in mid-session or expelled from school, the fees and charges paid (except caution money) will not be refunded inpart or in full.
- Ÿ Transfer certificate will not be issued until or unless all the dues are cleared.
- Application for withdrawal from school should be submitted to the office at least one week before the required time along with the charges.
